The LME Academy in collaboration *with the NC Hospital Association* is sponsoring the 4th part of our series on crisis response. This session will focus on developing and implementing person centered crisis plans that are both integrated in design and comprehensive in scope. This session will address the development of plans that address the issues that affect the individual and their natural supports, as well as the strengths and limitations of other community supports, providers, the LME, first responders, and local hospitals. This presentation will directly address the expectations of the Division of MH/DD/SAS regarding crisis plans, how to train staff, and policies and procedures, including assessments, forms, and formats that can facilitate this process. *(Attendance at previous sessions is not a prerequisite for attendance in this session.)*

Session Goals:

- Understanding the state requirements – Making it clear who is supposed to do what when
- Defining terms, processes, and desirable outcomes – for all involved parties
- Addressing the phases of a crisis from prevention through post-event - the planning that prevents overt chaos from controlling the circumstances
- Determination of rational scaled responses using assessments and other information effectively to determine when to move to the next level of response
- Pulling the pieces together into a plan that manages for all realistic threats through multiple contingencies

Target Audience: Crisis Triage/Screening Professionals, Hospital Emergency Department Professionals, First Responders Including Law Enforcement And Mobile Emergency Medical Personnel, Mobile Crisis Team Professionals, Community Support Providers, Care Management Providers, Access Unit Directors, and Workers.

Presenter: Mike Mayer, Ph.D. is the Executive Director of The Institute, an organization that promotes research, service and support innovation, and education related to people who have complex service and support needs. He is currently serving as a special consultant to the NC Hospital Association. He also is the VP of Education and Community Relations for RHA Health Services and has considerable national experience in crisis response services. He has developed trainings for several states to facilitate crisis service implementation.
